- **5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:** Turkish Food Codex Regulation on Contaminants; (36 page(s), in Turkish)
- **6. Description of content:** This Regulation covers maximum levels for certain contaminants in food and the responsibilities for the identification, prevention, reduction or elimination of the source of the risk associated with the contaminants.

The Regulation consists of nitrates, mycotoxins, heavy metals, 3-monochloropropanediol (3-MCPD), 3-MCPD fatty acid esters and glycidyl fatty acid esters, dioxins and dioxin-like polychlorinated biphenyls (PCB), polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH), melamine and their structural analogues, natural plant toxins, perchlorate and other contaminants.

With the enactment of the new Regulation, The Turkish Food Codex Regulation on Contaminants published in the Official Gazette dated 29/12/2011 and numbered 28157 shall be repealed.

- **7.** Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: Food safety, Maximum levels for contaminants

- 9. Proposed date of adoption: 1 April 2023

Proposed date of entry into force: This regulation enters into force on the date of its publication. Nevertheless, transitional period has been provided in Provisional Article 1.

Maximum levels for which an effective date is not specified in Annex-1 shall be applied from the date of entry into force of this Regulation.

The maximum levels with the effective date specified in Annex-1 are applied as of the mentioned date.
